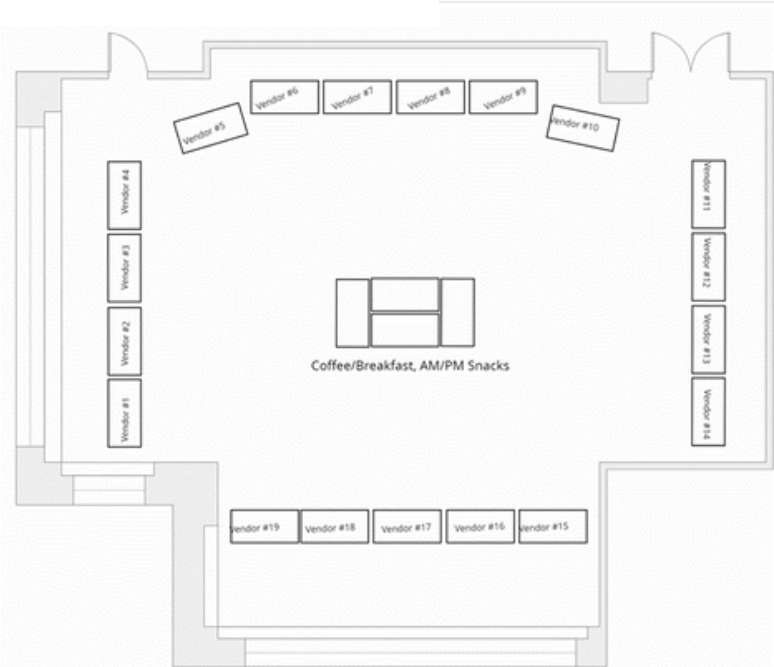
EXHIBITOR FLOOR PLAN
