


Workplace Health

- Relatively stable workers' compensation system
 - Small decreases in WC costs nationally last year with a general decrease in New England including a 3.5% decrease in Massachusetts
- Current issues relate to workplace changes from Covid pandemic and include:
 - Remote work
 - Potential future increase in workplace injuries
 - Covid cases particularly involving hospital employers
 - Wellness and well-being
 - Burn out and job turnover




Massachusetts Covid workers compensation claims

Identity crisis: What is our new role in workplace health programs?

- Can we shrink back to the pre-pandemic services?
 - Continuing demands related to Covid: e.g., respirator fit testing program
 - Are all the pre-pandemic services necessary or doable?
- Does occupational health have a substantial role regarding new workplace challenges?
 - Immense and important issues such as employee wellness/burnout, remote work, low-wage workers, etc.
 - The difficulty of too much responsibility with insufficient resources
 - The Great Resignation's impact on occupational health services
 - The challenges of establishing an appropriate role within an organization with other demanding and competing departments



Mass General Brigham Occupational Health Services: Our future plans

- Role definition based on emphasizing clinical expertise
 - Greater focus on workers compensation at clinics
 - Clinical consultant on workplace accommodations and safe patient handling
- Leveraging technology
 - Transforming Covid Pass system to an occupational health tool
 - Establishing a new employee on-boarding portal
- Establishing a centralized model reliant on remote workers
 - Remote services through centralized handling of new employee clearance, return to work, off-hours paging coverage
 - Local clinic sites for workers' compensation and specialized services that require an on-site presence
