- Injured worker Employer Injured worker
- Employer Adjuster Employer
- Adjuster Injured worker Adjuster
- Injured worker Treating provider(s) Injured worker
- Injured worker Attorney Injured worker
- Adjuster Defense attorney Adjuster
- Defense attorney IME doc Defense attorney

KEYS to EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION:

- Be respectful (do unto others . . .)
- Minimize "friction" (timely approvals/checks/response to inquiries)
- Be thorough (prior medical history, IW/ER relationship, etc)
- Be honest (clear expectations)
- Be prepared and proactive (anticipate barriers and address early)
- Be curious (ask questions, know "buzz words")
- Know your "end game"
